Cambewarra Estate Petit Rouge – Michael (Cambewarra NSW) <i>The colour of pink salmon, while the nose shows rosewater, turkish delight and a hint of musk. Delicious strawberry flavours dominate the palate.</i>	\$24.50

<i>This tasty white has starlight brightness with light straw hues. The nose is refreshingly tropical with hints of melon and pineapple.</i>	
Coolangatta Estate Sauvignon Blanc Verdelho (Shoalhaven Heads, NSW)	\$27.50
<i>Clean tropical fruit palate with a herbaceous character. Crisp acid and good length.</i>

<i>A light to medium bodied palate with tropical fruit and fruit salad flavours with touches of spice and minerals. Zesty and fruity, the finish is soft and long on the palate.</i>

<i>This blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Chambourcin and Tannat has been made in a style that is a reflection of the coastal region we live. This light to medium bodied wine shows earthy characters on the nose with subtle but persistent red berry flavours on the palate with a good clean finish.</i>	
Rosemount Estate Show Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon (Coonawarra, SA)	\$33.00
<i>Full bodied, the high quality, ripe fruit shines with flavours of plum, bramble and chocolate, complexed by cedar like oak and soft spice. A full flavoured and harmonious wine.</i>

<i>Colour is mid red. Lifted and gamey nose with powerful cherries dominating. A full palate with silky tannins and a clean rounded finish.</i>

<i>A soft berry red in the glass. Aromas of berries and spice are present on the nose. Ripe plums and subtle five spice flavours combine with supple tannins on the soft palate of this elegant wine.</i>

<i>A blend of 80% cabernet Sauvignon and 20% Merlot allowing soft fruit integration.</i>
